PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Tony Rotondo and Michael Mandikos are pleased to announce that we will be again staging the Mini-Residency in Prosthodontics in 2025.

Now in its 20th year, the Mini-Residency has earned a reputation as Australia's most respected prosthodontic education programs. Participants consistently praise not only the depth of learning and specialist mentorship, but also the supportive professional community that continues long after the program has concluded. The program is delivered over three intensive three-day modules (Thursday to Saturday), combining comprehensive theory with practical clinical application. Participants will gain the greatest benefit from the Mini-Residency if they have, or are able to identify, a suitable rehabilitation or complex restorative case shortly after completing Module 1. While this is encouraged, it is not a prerequisite for enrolment.

The time between modules provides participants with the opportunity to apply new concepts in clinical practice before returning to discuss their experiences and build on their learning in the next module.

This program equips participants with the knowledge and confidence to apply the principles and techniques of complex restorative dentistry in clinical practice. By the completion of the third module, you will be well prepared to diagnose, treatment plan and manage complex restorative cases with confidence.

To ensure continuity of learning, participants are required to enrol in the *complete three-module program*. As each module builds on the previous one, registrations cannot be accepted part-way through the program.

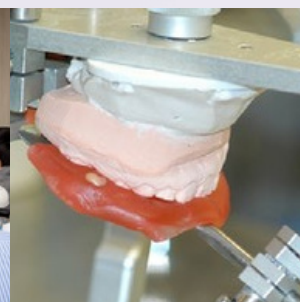
- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis.
